## ✓ CHECK WHEN COMPLETED!

### ■ READ JOHN 1

John the Baptist knew who he was. Do you? Do you know why God has put you on this earth? Answer the question posed to John, "What do you have to say about yourself?"

### ■ READ GENESIS 12

Abraham was already wealthy and comfortable when called to leave. The challenges of change can be difficult, especially when we are use to what we already have. How do you process change? What helps you in change?

### ■ *Something to Chew On*

In 2 Kings 20, King Hezekiah became deathly ill and was told to set his affairs in order. He wept before God and the Father heard his prayers. But instead of directly healing him, God told Isaiah in verse 7 to, "Make an ointment from figs." So Hezekiah's servants spread the ointment over the boil, and Hezekiah recovered. There were times when I've felt guilty relying on modern medicine instead of God's direct healing. Now I'm completely at peace that God can direct the creation of cures for doctors to apply to the sick. The Father is not limited in his ability to bring about healing.

### ■ READ 1 SAMUEL 2

Have you ever looked at others and said to yourself, "I wish I had what they have?" Or you wonder why others are thriving while you're struggling? 1 Samuel 2:9 promises, "He will protect his faithful ones, ..." Her prayer reminds us not to be arrogant, for "Those who were well fed are now starving, and those who were starving are now full ... The Lord makes some poor and others rich; he brings some down and lifts others up. He lifts the poor from the dust and the needy from the garbage dump. He sets them among princes, ..." Isn't this encouraging? Follow the Lord, He will lift you up in due time.

### ■ READ JOHN 2

Who were the ones to see the miracle at this wedding? I find it interesting that the most important people at this wedding didn't even realize a miracle had taken place. How can you position yourself to see God move?

### ■ READ GENESIS 13

How did Abram resolve his conflict with Lot? See verse 8-9. Why was Abram able to freely give to Lot whatever land he wanted? Who was Abram's provider? Above everything you own, how do you see the Father as your source?

### ■ APPLICATION

Memorize and apply the Verse of the Day. Show the Father's Love to others in one tangible way.

### PONDER
